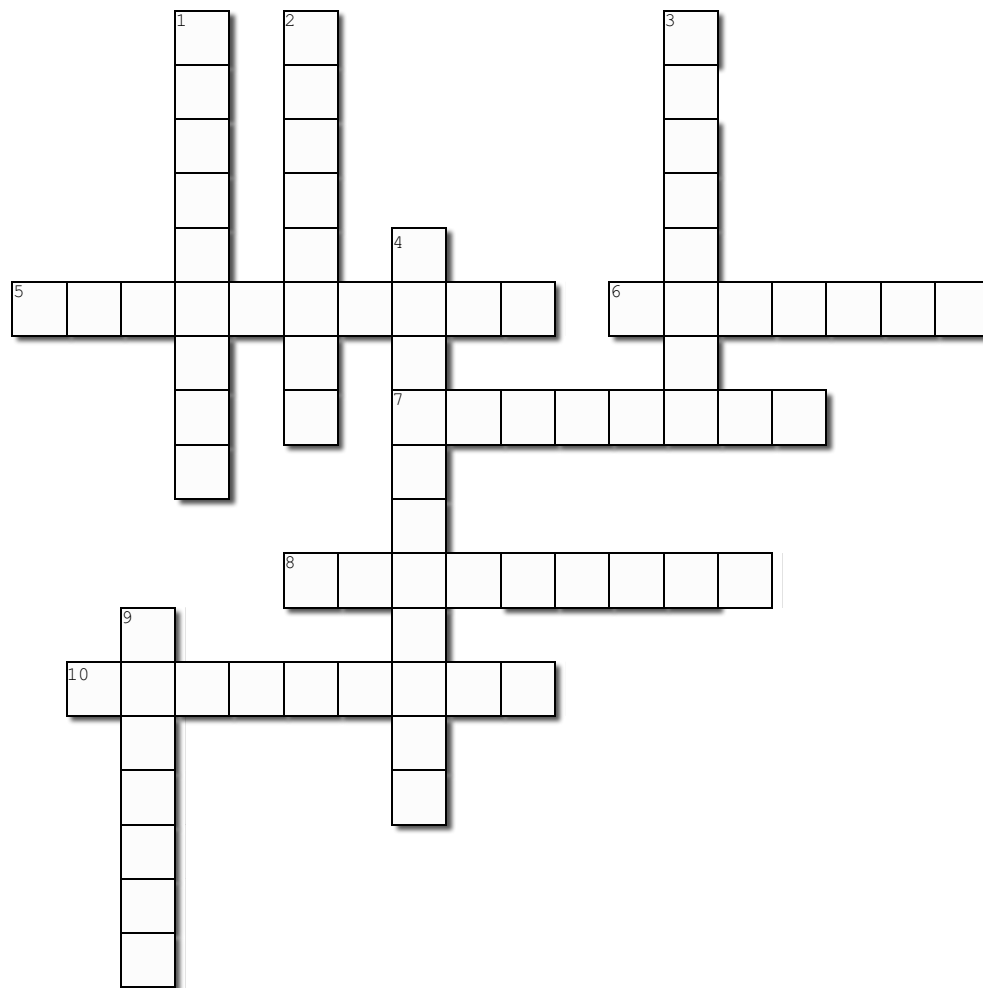


Mississippi State Capitol Crossword
