




Mississippi Department of Revenue Distributions of Collections for Fiscal Year 2019







Total General Fund Receipts Fiscal Year 2018 \$5,490,283,708







(") State only taxes interest and dividends income.



A temporary and retroactive surchange is in effect from 2020 to 2023, bringing the rate to 11.55s for businesses with income over \$4 million. In addition to regular income taxes, many states impose other taxes on corporations cuch as gross receipts taxes and capital stock taxes. Some states also impose an alternative minimum tax and special rates on financial institutions.
